Attitude and Discipline:

- Principal Dr. Pankaja R P addressed the issue pertaining to attitude and discipline of the students. It was a general observation that the students are not behaving proper with Tamil and English faculties. She has advised the concerned department HoD's and faculties to put more efforts to improve the behavior of the students and see that they maintain discipline in the class room.
- Dr. Sakthivel Murugan M shared his thought on attitude and discipline. He advised that everyone in the department should take care and insist the students about the

relevance of the Language and English subjects. So that they behave decently with Tamil and English staffs.

- Principal Madam given a task to HoD's on "How discipline is going to be implemented in each department?" The same to be submitted by the HoDs on or before 25th September 2017.

Examinations:

- Principal advised the HoDs to inculcate the importance of CAT and Internal Assignment to students.
- She also advised the HoD's to share the importance of attendance percentage on a regular basis.
- It is unanimously resolved in the meeting that the University rules of attendance will be followed in our College for forthcoming examinations. Those who have obtained 75% attendance are eligible to appear for the examination. Those who obtained between 60% and 74% have to pay Condonation fee to appear for the examination. Henceforth, no consideration will be given to students less than the stipulated percentage.
- First year NCC and Sports person lists has to be given to COE Office by the concerned faculties for attendance record.

- Dr. Pankaja R.P., Principal of the College welcomed the gatherings.
- Prof. Ganapathy S, HoD, Dept of Management Studies read the previous minutes of the IQAC meeting held on 22.09.2017.

The following are the points were discussed in the meeting:

1. Principal Madam pointed out the importance of students' participation in other College events. She has appreciated Department of Commerce where students have participated and prizes won at MCC Inter-Collegiate meet and got laurels to our College. She has highlighted that students' participation in other Colleges is considered to be an important Quality Indicator in NAAC Assessments.
2. More number of FDP can be organized in connection with ICTACT.
3. Principal Madam insisted the department HoD's to make MoU formally. The target to complete the MoU process on or before 16th October 2017.
4. Out of 1000 points in NAAC Assessment, 300 points is given for Teaching-Learning & Evaluation. Therefore, Principal Madam advised the IQAC members to concentrate more on the following points:
 - a. Peer-Learning System to be introduced & it is to be monitored
 - b. Bridge Course
 - c. Open Book System
 - d. Teaching Methodology viz., M-Learning, E-Learning, Video Conference, Digital Resources, etc.
 - e. Students Satisfaction Survey
 - f. Remedial Programmes
 - g. Glossary & Acronym can be prepared for all subjects
5. Dr. SakthivelMurugan highlighted the importance of Research Innovation criteria. He has requested the faculty to publish their research article in a UGC listed journals.

6. Dr. SakthivelMurugan insisted the importance of Question Bank for all the subjects. Existing Question Banks can be revisited and the same can be printed in a book format.
7. Principal Madam advised the members to revisit their department syllabus. She has insisted that the entire syllabus should contain Program / Course Outcome and Subject Outcome. Further she has insisted to bring-in employability and entrepreneurship related subjects can be introduced.
8. Dr. SakthivelMurugan has advised the members to gather the Prominent Alumni of the College and conduct Alumni Meet.
9. Certification Course viz., Tally, MS-Office, etc., can be introduced with a minimum of 30 hours for the students as a Value-Added Courses. He has highlighted that Department of Physical Education has organized 'Certification in Yoga' and the same can be continued for the current academic year onwards as well.
10. Dr. SakthivelMurugan directed the HoD of Visual Communication to assign Short Films tasks to the students.
11. It is resolved that Administrative Officer should take care of ID Card for missed out students of second and third year.
